

IF YOU HAVE DENTAL INSURANCE YOU MUST COMPLETE THIS FORM

Dental plans are designed to share in the cost of your dental care, not to completely pay for those costs. The amount your plan pays is determined by the agreement negotiated by your employer with the insurance company.

A dental insurance plan may not cover certain procedures or preventive treatments. This does not mean that these treatments are unnecessary. Parents should be aware of the exclusions and limitations of their child's dental plan but should not let those factors determine their treatment decisions. **Please keep in mind, the treatment we recommend for your child is based on their dental needs not their insurance coverage!**

1. We recommend a fluoride treatment twice a year.

I want my child to have the recommended twice a year fluoride treatment even though my insurance may not pay for it.

if my insurance won't pay for the fluoride treatment, I do not want it for my child.

2. The doctors will recommend x-rays when needed for your child.

I want my child to have the recommended x-rays when needed.

If my insurance company won't pay for the x-rays, I do not want the recommended x-rays.

3. The doctors usually use "white, tooth colored" material for the fillings.

I want the "white" fillings even though my insurance may not cover them.

If my insurance company does not pay for "white" fillings, then I want silver fillings for my child.
